

CHICAGO COURSE ON PREACHING

SUMMER INTENSIVE 2024

Working pastors need to continually make progress in their preaching. Finding opportunities to do so is difficult given the busyness of ministry life. The Summer Intensive is a three-week intensive, residential training opportunity in expositional preaching for pastors. Modeled after the full Chicago Course, the Summer Intensive seeks to bring the best of the Course to pastors who are unable to come to the Course during the academic year.

In order to qualify for the Intensive you must be a pastor who preaches at least 10 times a year. Additionally, you must have attended at least four Workshops on Biblical Exposition or taken all six online Genre Courses.

What:

- Each week focuses on a different biblical genre. The 2023 Summer Intensive will be given to the study of OT History (1-2 Kings), Gospels (Matthew), and Apocalyptic (Revelation).
- Instructional hours will be dedicated to genre principles, elements of persuasion, and portraits of preaching.
- Participants will complete 20 sermon preparation worksheets and preach 3 sermons in a small group setting
- Space is limited.

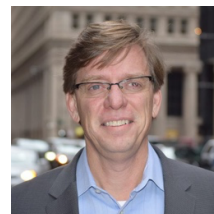
