OVERVIEW

Each course is designed to provide students with tools, models, and opportunities for preaching. To this end, there are five components to each course:

- 1. Watch the online videos and complete the study questions or sermon evaluation. These eight videos include five instructional sessions and three sample expositions.
- 2. Prepare two assigned passages using the Sermon Preparation Worksheet.
- 3. Read assigned texts (approximately 1,000 pages) and write one critical book review.
- 4. Prepare and preach two sermons from the assigned passages.
- 5. Meet with your dedicated coach for feedback and conversation.

Here is a <u>recommended schedule</u> for completing the assigned work in the 16-week period.
