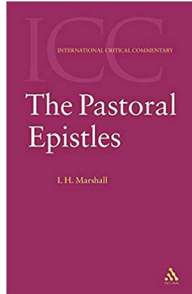


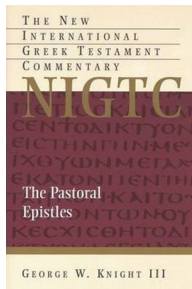

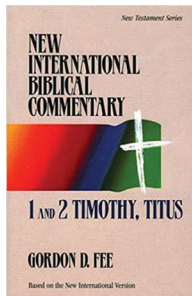
**The Pastoral Epistles** (*International Critical Commentary*)  
I. Howard Marshall

Marshall's work is thorough and challenging and provocative. It is worth reading carefully. Dave adds this caveat: "I can't endorse every conclusion that Marshall reaches, but his work is worth engaging critically."



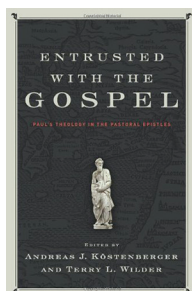
**The Pastoral Epistles** (*New International Greek Testament Commentary*)  
George W. Knight, III

As with most volumes in this series, Knight's commentary is especially helpful at the linguistic level. Knight's work is extensive and his conclusions are mostly level-headed.



**1 & 2 Timothy, Titus** (*New International Biblical Commentary*)  
Gordon D. Fee

This is a good commentary on the letters to Timothy. William adds this caveat: "This commentary is recommended with the exception of the material on chapter 2 of the letter and the issues of gender. In these comments, Fee goes beyond the text to substantiate his own (egalitarian) view."



**Entrusted with the Gospel: Paul's Theology in the Pastoral Epistles**  
ed. Andreas Kostenberger, Terry Wilder

This is an excellent set of academic articles on exegetical and theological aspects of the pastoral epistles. It's not organized as a commentary, but rather it is topically driven. A worthwhile read.
