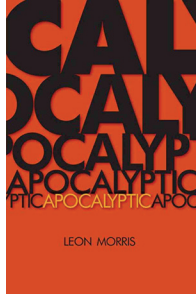


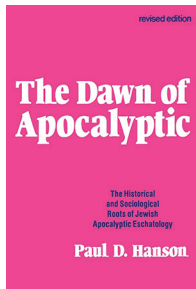

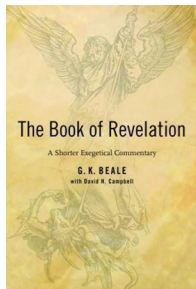
Apocalyptic Leon Morris

Written in 1972 at 101 pages it is still the best book on the subject. He gets the main things right and does it with supreme clarity.



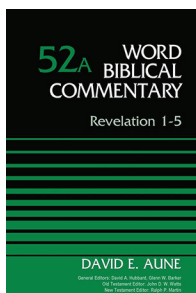
The Dawn of Apocalyptic Paul D. Hanson
