- I. Title: Director of Online Training
- II. Vision: The Charles Simeon Trust has this aim: to promote the growth of the gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the world by training an emerging generation of Biblical expositors.

 - design and implement quality control metrics
 - develop Online Course curriculum documentation
 - provide customer service via phone and email
 - track and report enrollment data
 - with the Director of Ministries, oversee producing new Courses
 - coordinate pilot groups for new Courses
 - oversee producing Courses in all languages
 - create and execute an annual budget
- Workshops on Biblical Exposition
 - compile photo and video from Workshops and catalog them
 - oversee editing and posting of resources from Workshops
 - other responsibilities as assigned
- Residential Training
 - serve as a Practice Group Leader (as needed)

- Gospel Resources and Partnerships
 - with the Director of Workshops, manage the Media Manager
 - review and approve social media posts
 - strategize how to leverage social media to promote initiatives and community
 - collaborate with team to maintain and update website media
 - oversee website permissions and troubleshooting
 - serve as producer on podcasts and media series (e.g., Sunday Dinner, Getting Started)
 - lead efforts to create and maintain any apps for the organization
 - establish and maintain relationships with resource partner organizations
 - define criteria for resource selection and production
 - other responsibilities as assigned
