CHICAGO COURSE ON PREACHING

God's Word is essential to the life and ministry of the church. Preaching is the primary means of communicating God's Word to the church. The challenge of rightly handling the Bible and communicating it in our world requires conviction, competency, and lots of practice. The Chicago Course on Preaching (CCP) offers rigorous and church-based training to meet the need.

GET REPS

One unique aspect of the CCP is that it is an experiential preaching lab. Much of your time is spent working on your own work. You will prepare over 200 sermon outlines, discussing each one in a group setting. You will preach over 40 times, getting quality feedback. Our goal is to help you develop "muscle memory" like an athlete and find your own voice. As your competency increases, so will your confidence.

DEVELOP SKILLS

The daily instructions and practice group times focus on developing your abilities and instincts in handling and communicating the Bible. At the CCP you will develop proficiency in exegesis, gain strategies for theological reflection, and learn techniques for persuasive delivery.

No one takes the CCP alone. You will train and grow alongside other members of a cohort. You will sharpen one another, serve together, support one another, and join a network of expositors around the globe who work hard to preach well.




